

- ☐ **Service:** This is the type of job we are asking you to do! If you are a **check-taker**, the service is a **proofreading**.
- ☐ Language pair: This information tells you what the source language and target language is.
- ☐ **Work amount:** The amount of words that needs to be **checked.**




☐ After hitting the button: "View Details," you'll land on this page. You can see what this translation is all about; you are also able to check the document. Now, make a decision: Accept or Decline.





After clicking on "Accept". You'll find yourself on this page. You can Immediately start your proofreading by clicking on "Translate".




How to translate in Smartcat?




How to translate in SmartCat

□ The red square marks the source language. The green square marks the space where the translator puts their translation of the source language. Your job is to proofread this translation. After you are done with check-taking of section 1, you'll proceed to section 2 with Ctrl + ENTER.



How to place comments in SmartCat

☐ As a check-taker. You'll need to give feedback to our translators. Here's how you add comments on a particular section:
